BURN DAY STATUS - 530-274-7928

(Western Nevada County)

Three types of status:

- 1) Burning prohibited: No burning allowed; based on air quality (NSAQ) and conditions, i.e. wind, and low humidity (Cal Fire)
- 2) Burning allowed with permit: (Typically Spring & Fall) **Residential LE-62 Permit**; fires restricted to 4'X4', 10' clearance
Non-Residential land requires LE-5 Permit and Air Pollution Permit
- 3) Open burning allowed no permit required: (Typically Winter) **Residential or non-residential permits not required**; no fire size restriction. **Ag land with residence MAY require LE-5. Non-Residential land requires Air Pollution Permit**
